

You will have 14 days to decide if you want to sell or store grain.

If nothing is done, it automatically goes into storage, which starts from the average date the grain was delivered.

STORAGE RATES

Storage rates on open store or warehouse receipt corn and soybeans will be:

Corn	\$.0013 per bushel per day
Soybeans	\$.0016 per bushel per day

Warehouse receipts issued for the 9-month loan program will prepay nine months of storage. Unused storage will be refunded at the time the grain is purchased.

DRYING AND SHRINK

* Each load stands alone. No average moisture.

Soybeans	13.1 %-13.5 %	1.75 % Shrink

	14.1 %-14.5 %	5.25 % Shrink
	14.6 %-15.0 %	7.00 % Shrink

Soybeans over 15 % are subject to rejection.

CORN:\$.0013 per bushel per day
 SOYBEANS:\$.0016 per bushel per day
 START DATE:Average date grain was delivered
 MOISTURE:Corn 15 %, and Soybeans 13 %
 PRICING DATE:On or before October 15, 2012

GRAIN BANK POLICY

#2 CORN (Will be shrunk to 14 % moisture)

NO ADDITIONAL SHRINKAGE

NO IN OR OUT CHARGES

(as long as grain goes back to farm processed as feed).

IF CORN IS NOT USED UP WITHIN 90 DAYS, STORAGE WILL START WITH A RATE OF \$.03 PER BUSHEL PER MONTH.

* If grain is sold or applied to account, storage will be charged from date of arrival to date of sale and grain taxes will also be charged.

* Customer must maintain a balance in Grain Bank or be charged for any grain he is short as each load is delivered. When Grain Bank balance is zero, grain will be charged to your account. Once grain is charged out, there will be no replacement of grain allowed. **NO EXCEPTIONS. NO CREDIT BACK FOR ANY REASON.**
